



Pilot Retention

 ACE it Pilot: 46% reenrolled for fall



What's Next

- Train 150 faculty & staff coaches
- Add 5 students per faculty/staff coach per semester (max 15-20)
- Full scale 2019


- My only regret is that students who are not freshmen can't join the program as well.
